The well was put on production on May 7, 2008 and is currently producing 2.45 Mmcfd of natural gas and 32 barrels of oil, at 2,700 psi flowing pressure.

Sharon is the operator and has a 35.844% working interest in the N.W. Speaks Robertson #1 well.

Based on the Company's log analysis, the well has several shallower potential Wilcox gas zones, to be evaluated, after depletion of the current zone. In addition, based on the Company's interpretation of the seismic and geology there are two more development locations which could be drilled on this structure.
